

GUIDELINES FOR EPOSTER SUBMISSIONS

At the European Update, posters will be presented as ePosters, a digital source displayed in an endless loop on large flat screens. The ePosters will be continuously available for viewing during the congress in the Digital Lounge in the foyer of the venue.

Please note: Poster print outs cannot be displayed at the European Update

Creating and Submitting your ePoster:

After submitting your abstracts and having received a confirmation to submit an ePoster, you can create your ePoster.

The ePoster standards are:

- Format:** Microsoft Powerpoint 2007 and 2010 *.pptx-file
Using Keynote or Microsoft Powerpoint 2013 please export your ePoster as a *.pptx-file, compatible with Powerpoint 2010. Do not hesitate to contact our technicians if you have any questions.
- Layout:** 16:9 landscape. Please use the following preset for:
Microsoft 2007 und 2010: pptx-preset
- Slides:** 3 Slides maximum per ePoster. We recommend the following sequence:
slide 1: title, author, affiliation and disclosure
slide 2: introduction, question and methodology
slide 3: results, remarks and conclusion
- Media files:** In case your ePoster contains media files, e.g. movies, audio or animations, please attach a *.zip-file with all media files necessary to your ePoster. It is your responsibility to ensure that intellectual material is correctly and accurately cited.
- Upload:** Prior to the European Update we will prepare a link, where you can upload your ePoster and, if necessary, your media files.
